Jeremiah 32 v7

Hanamel son of Shallum your uncle is going to come to you and say, "Buy my field at Anathoth, because as nearest relative it is your right and duty to buy it."

Jeremiah 32 v 9-12

Jeremiah ch 32 v 17

Ah, Sovereign Lord, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

Jeremiah ch 32 v21-23

You brought your people Israel out of Egypt with signs and wonders, by a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and with great terror. You gave them this land you had sworn to give to their ancestors, a land flowing with milk and honey. They came in and took possession of it, but they did not obey you or follow your law; they did not do what you commanded them to do. So you brought all this disaster on them

Jeremiah ch 32 v37b - 40

I will bring them back to this place, and let them live in safety. They shall be my people, and I will be their God; then I will give them singleness of heart and action, so that they will fear me and that all will then go well for them and their children after them. And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, I will never stop good to them; and I will inspire them to fear me so that they will never turn away from me.
